


Create Your Chart – Step 2

 Click <u>Chart drawing, Ascendant</u> for quick access to your natal chart and calculations











Find ANY Degree/Planet—Step I


 First note: Astrology is a symbol system.
Learn the signs & planets, or refer to them here.






Find ANY Degree/Planet—Step 2

- There are 360
 degrees in the
 circle of houses
 (pieces of pie).
- Each sign of the zodiac takes up 30 degrees (0 – 29).
- Each house can range in size, depending on the distance form the equator.




Find Mars at 0 Virgo and note all 30 degrees of Virgo. Note Virgo in the 6th house and 5 degrees of the 7th.

Test: Find 0 – 29 Virgo



Did you get it correct?



Virgo is in the last 25 degrees of the 10th house and the first 5 degrees of the 11th house. Now find were Mars in Virgo will transit in your chart!
